

Free Application for Federal Student Aid

If you are in college or are planning to attend college, don't forget to apply for financial aid!

Every school requires the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to be submitted after January 1st. You must complete the FAFSA if you want to be considered for federal student aid. Your application will be processed in about four weeks if you use the paper application or about one week if you apply on line. Priority is given to applicants who submit their information by March 2nd.

Paper applications can be found at most public libraries and college campuses, or feel free to contact LIFETIME if you having trouble locating them.

If you plan to apply online, you will need a valid social security number, email address, and an estimate of your income earnings or copies of your tax information submitted for the year.

If you do not know your exact income information, you can still submit your request for financial aid since what is most important is that your application is on-time. Your exact figures can be updated as soon as you receive them.
